I. NAME

The name of the corporation is RUSSIAN RIVER FLY FISHERS,
INC.

II. PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

(a) The specific and primary purposes are:

1. To advance, promote, practice, and teach the art of angling with artificial flies.
2. To advance, promote, practice, and teach the art of tying artificial flies.
3. To promote conservation of recreational resources and to protect, conserve, and increase the population of wild fresh water, salt water, and migratory game fish.
4. To encourage our members and fishermen everywhere to practice the high standards of sportsmanship long associated with fly fishing.
5. To support the fly fisherman's interest to the end that suitable portions of public waters be reserved for angling with artificial flies only.
6. To make recommendations and representations to state and/or federal authorities for the improvement of water conditions, to protect, conserve, and increase the

population of wild fresh water, salt water, and migratory game fish.

7. To cooperate with fishing clubs, associations, leagues, or other community organizations, wherever possible by providing instruction in all phases of fly-fishing for teenagers and adults.

8. To give and promote entertainment, lectures, social affairs, celebrations, exhibitions, games, and amusements of any and all descriptions for the general enjoyment and instruction of the members.

9. To encourage family participation in activities of the organization.

10. To do all things necessary to accomplish the purposes hereinabove set forth to the extent permitted to corporations pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California.

(b) General purposes and powers are to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of California, including the power to contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property; provided, however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of this corporation.

III. ORGANIZATION

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of California and does

not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof and it is organized for nonprofit purposes.

IV. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The county in this State where the principal office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is located is Sonoma County.
