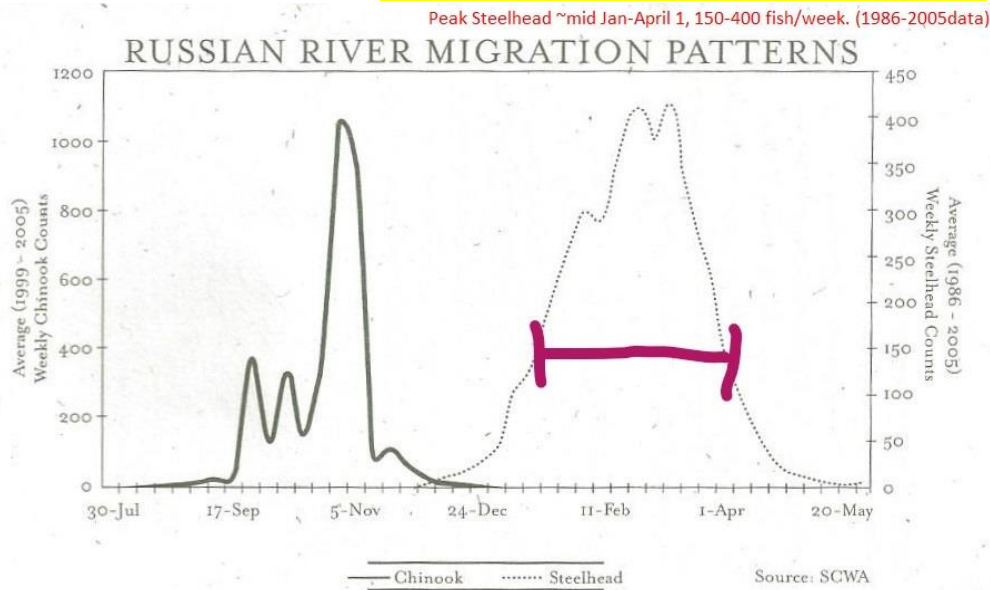

Fishing the Russian, Gualala, Garcia:

- Get a Streamtime map.
- See our website: <https://www.rrflyfisher.org/river-flows--fishing-reports.html>
 - Russian/Gualala, Call 707-944-5533 for recording, Russian >300/ Gualala >150 cfs
 - Garcia call 707-822-3164, fishable if Navarro > 200 cfs
 - Set up a daily river flow alert at usgs.gov for your target river
 - Or send text to waternow@usgs.gov.
 - Russian = 11467000
 - Gualala = 11467510
 - Navarro = 11468000
- Barbless hooks = year round, Artificial lures 4/1-10/31.

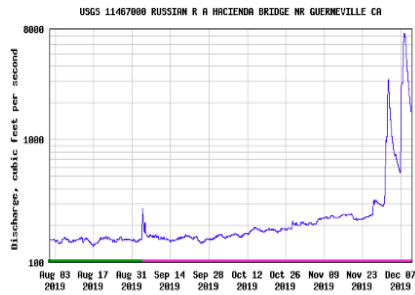
August to May data for years 1986-2005: Steelhead peak mid Jan – April 150-400 fish/week



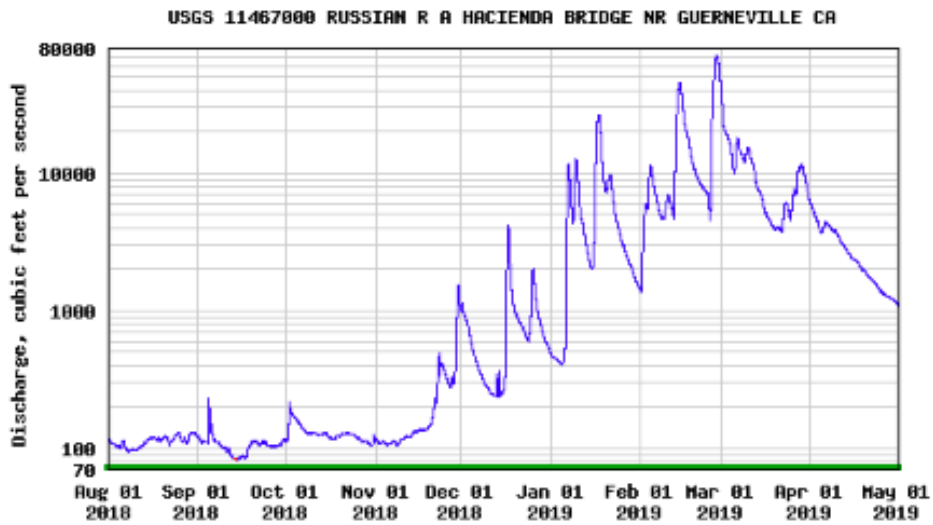
 <p>Chinook Salmon</p> <p>Black color on lower jaw and tongue</p> <p>Spotting on upper and lower lobes of tail</p>	 <p>Coho Salmon</p> <p>Black color on lower jaw, tongue; teeth embedded in white gum line</p> <p>BEWARE! Adipose fin is removed on recovery Coho salmon</p> <p>Spotting only on upper lobe of tail</p>
<p>If Mouth has Black, Put It Back!</p> <p>The upstream migration of endangered Coho salmon and threatened Chinook salmon overlap Steelhead trout season. Steelhead are distinguished by a white mouth while the mouth of Coho and Chinook has black.</p>

 <p>Steelhead Trout</p> <p>No black color on lower jaw and tongue</p> <p>Release wild Steelhead with intact adipose fin! No adipose fin on hatchery Steelhead!</p> <p>Spotting on upper and lower lobes of tail</p>
