

## Yuba River Trout Outing March 9-10, 2019

The Russian River Fly Fishers have reserved the weekend of March 9-10, 2018 for an outing at the University of California Sierra Foothill Research & Extension Center property on the Lower Yuba River. This reservation will allow our club to have exclusive access to the UC property along the river above the Hwy 20 bridge. The quarry are wild rainbow trout, and March is prime time for spring bug hatches such as the Skwala stonefly. The regulations allow only artificial lures with barbless hooks. Note that because the Yuba is a large river, this outing should be limited to active anglers who can walk rough trails and wade fast runs.

The Lower Yuba is about a 3½ hour drive from Santa Rosa, so members may want to arrange their own overnight housing in Marysville or Yuba City. There is also a campground on the river at Sycamore Ranch.

We will be limiting the number of RRFF anglers (members only) on the property to a maximum of 15 for the weekend. The cost to each angler will be \$50, payable to Russian River Fly Fishers, due by February 15. The reservations will be non-refundable, although transferal to another RRFF member will be allowed.
